To James Fowle Baldwin Marshall

Malden W.Va. July 19, 1882

Dear General: I suppose by this time that you are at Hampton again. Your letter containing the check for \$215.50 has been forwarded to me from Tuskegee.

I am here resting for a few weeks and do not go to Tuskegee till after the first of August. I hear from there that things are going on nicely.

I thank you for your advice in regard to keeping our accounts straight. We are making a special effort to keep every thing straight so that we can have a detailed acct of our rec[e]ipts and expenditures printed and sent to each donor directly after the work is done. Directly after I go to Tuskegee I will try to write you just how every thing stands.

Miss Davidson is at her home in Ohio resting.

I was sorry not to see you and Mrs. Marshall at Hampton. Yours faithfully
